Scholarship Information

To be considered for this scholarship a child must:

- be at least 5 years old on the date at the start of the session (must present a birth certificate)
- swim at a beginning level (LTS Levels 1-3, see below)
- commit to a full two-week, 10-lesson session
- provide own transportation, and
- provide proof of financial need and

Documentation of financial need consists of at least one of the following:

- 1. Participation in free/reduced school lunch program or
- 2. Letter or card from an official social service agency, SNAP or Medicaid

Some scholarships for adults are also available.

Selection Process

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of financial need, on a first-come, first-serve basis. The VAC Scholarship Committee must approve all applications. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Scholarship recipients will receive an award notification by e-mail or USPS for each award. Such notification is valid for one scholarship only.
